Molly Morrow's Photographs and Annie Morrow Alley's Story of Ellensburg Rodeo Featured in *Northwest Magazine*

Ellensburg, Wash – Readers of *Northwest Magazine* will find an eight-page feature story on the Ellensburg Rodeo in the publication's August 2008 issue, including images by local photographer Molly Morrow and an article by Annie Morrow Alley.

The piece focuses on the rodeo's leadership in the industry, including its success at drawing new audiences to the sport while maintaining a loyal fan base. The article is part of Morrow and Alley's ongoing work with the magazine, which highlights life in the Pacific Northwest. The magazine is regularly available locally where magazines are sold, however, Super One Foods and the Dakota Café will sell this issue for an extended period of time. The Northwest magazine will also be available at the Ellensburg Rodeo.

As an accredited Pro Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) photographer and the official photographer of the Ellensburg Rodeo Royal Court, Morrow's images of the hometown event and other PRCA rodeos have been published regionally and nationally. Select rodeo imagery and photographs featuring area ranch life are on display locally at the Dakota Café, Amazing Frames and beginning rodeo weekend through September at Ellensburg WineWorks.

Alley, a 1997 graduate of Ellensburg High School and a 2001 communications graduate of Washington State University was the 1997 Ellensburg Rodeo Queen. She works as a freelance writer in Seattle.
